

# Attention Owners/Exhibitors of Foreign Registered Dogs

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1. The dog show rules are posted on the AKC Web site at: http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf Most important to note are the following:

- 1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
- 2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards.* To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf

If you have questions or need assistance with registration or obtaining an extension, please contact the AKC Special Services Department at: awards@akc.org or (919) 233-9767 (followed by selecting option 4).

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotti Romagnoli, Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows & Keeshonden. Breeds designated as ramp optional may, at the discretion of the judge, be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition. Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

## Thursday, August 1, 2024 & Friday, August 2, 2024 Semen Evaluation Clinic Breeding Soundness Examination

A breeding soundness examination will be performed by Dr. Orsolya Balogh, DVM, Diplomate of the American College of Theriogenologists (Animal Reproduction) and Resident. Dr. Gabriela Sousa, DVM, AKC/CHF Theriogenology Resident from the Virginia-Maryland College of Veterinary Medicine, Virginia Tech.

## Breeding Soundness Examination (BES)

Semen will be manually collected from the dog and a complete semen evaluation to include motility, morphology, concentration, and number of breeding doses will be reported. Recommendations will be made on suitability for freezing. The fee is **\$100.00**.

## Test Shipment

Test shipment evaluation will include all portions of the breeding soundness examination, but will also evaluate the ability of semen to withstand chilled shipment conditions. The semen will be processed, centrifugation, and extended, in 2 different extenders over a 48-hour period and packaged according to industry standards. The semen will be evaluated at 24 and 48 hours for survival and motility. The results will be reported, including all portions of the BSE, longevity and which extender provided the best results. An overall recommendation of the stud dog's ability to survive chilled shipment will be made. The fee is **\$125.00**

The Pee Wee Event is for children from the ages of 5 to under 9 years of age. Each Pee Wee class consists of the child and a responsible adult which must be in the ring with the Pee Wee. The dog must be at least 4 months of age and have the proper lead and collar. At an All-Breed event, all AKC fully recognized and Miscellaneous Class breeds are allowed to enter, including dogs with a PAL listing. In addition, FSS breeds and All-American dogs may be allowed at the discretion of the Club. The responsible adult is responsible for the control of the dog outside the ring. Clubs must provide an additional lead if the mentor inside the ring feels that it is necessary for the safety of the dog and the Pee Wee. A Release of Liability must be completed before the Pee Wee may enter the Pee Wee Event. For more information on the Pee Wee Event, please refer to the AKC website at:

## **Coonhound Bench Show**



Hosted by the National Treeing Walker Coonhound Association August 3, 2024, after Best in Show Spectators Welcome!

### An introduction to Bench Show

All six AKC-recognized Coonhound Breeds and FSS American Leopard Hounds will be eligible to compete in a Coonhound Bench Show hosted by the National Treeing Walker Coonhound Association! Coonhound Bench Shows are a tribute to days gone by, developed as a way for houndsmen to show their dogs (often with limited available space) prior to embarking on the night's hunt. In a Bench Show, dogs are exhibited on a "Bench," a special type of table or platform, and judged according to how well they meet the breed standard. Most judges today will also examine the dog on the ground and will request a down and back.



There are three show titles that can be earned: **CCH**-Champion, **CGCH**-Grand Champion, and **CSG**-Supreme Grand Champion. Dogs that have not earned a title are considered "Open" and should be entered in the Open Classes according to breed and age. Dogs which have already earned their CCH can proceed to the "Champion" Classes. Dogs must be at least 6 months old and have an AKC registration number.

Unlike conformation events, entries for Bench Shows are taken on the day of the show, prior to the advertised deadline. The deadline for this event will be available at www.akccoonhounds.org under "Events Center."



## **AKC Sanctioned** 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition Entry Fee: \$16.00 per puppy

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates.

## Section 1 - Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.





If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
